The Gift of Life

My sister Linda recently forwarded an email to me. It occurred to me that this might be an appropriate thought to share as we approach the season of Thanksgiving. The author of the piece is unknown, but the claim is that it was found in the billfold of Coach Paul Bear Bryant after he died. It is called "The Magic Bank Account."

Imagine that you had won the following *PRIZE* in a contest: Each morning your bank would deposit \$86,400 in your private account for your use. However, the *PRIZE* has the following rules.

1. Everything that you didn't spend during each day would be taken away from you.
2. You may not simply transfer money into some other account.
3. You may only spend it.
4. Each morning upon awakening, the bank opens your account with another \$86,400 for that day.
5. The bank can end the game without warning; at any time it can say, "Game over!" It can close the account and you will not receive a new one.

What would you personally do? You would buy anything and everything you wanted, right? Not only for yourself, but for all the people you love and care for. Even for people you don't know, because you couldn't possibly spend it all on yourself. You would try to spend every penny, and use it all, because you knew it would be replenished in the morning.

ACTUALLY, THE GAME IS REAL! Shocked? Yes! Each of us is already the winner of this *PRIZE! We just can't seem to see it. The PRIZE IS *TIME*.

Each morning we awaken to receive 86,400 seconds as a gift of life. And, when we go to sleep at night, any remaining time is not credited to us. What we haven't used up that day is forever lost. Yesterday is forever gone. Each morning the account is refilled, but the bank can dissolve your account at any time without warning. SO, what will YOU do with your 86,400 seconds? Those seconds are worth so much more than the same amount in dollars.

Life is a precious gift entrusted to us. At this Thanksgiving season when we are encouraged to express thanks for so many abundant blessings, may we not forget that one of the most precious gifts is time...every second of every day...86,400 seconds every day!

Prayer Point: Necessary Faith

Last time we talked about "NOW FAITH"--this week we will look at "NECESSARY FAITH". Did you know that if you don't pray in faith—believing that God will answer—there is really no need to pray? Before you turn me off, meditate on Hebrews 11:6, "And without faith it is impossible to please God, because anyone who comes to Him must believe that He exists and that He rewards those who earnestly seek Him." Faith goes beyond believing that God exists—it is actually "existing with Him" moment by moment: talking with Him, listening to Him, walking step in step with Him throughout our day, and obediently following His commands (found in His Word). There is no doubt that the person who lives in this manner is earnestly seeking God. Many times we ask why God isn't answering our prayers when perhaps we should be asking, "Am I earnestly seeking Him, to discern His will, so I can pray accordingly?" Sometimes a little "house-cleaning" may be necessary before we pray. When we earnestly seek God and pray in (NECESSARY) faith, He is more than pleased to reward us by answering our prayers. Do you need to "clean up" your prayer life? I certainly do!


