Deep in the Arabian desert is a small fortress that still exists to this day. It stands silently on the vast expanse of a dry and barren desert. Thomas Edward Lawrence, known as "Lawrence of Arabia," often used that fortress. It wasn't very big or impressive physically, but it saved his life many times.

The reason why it was so important to Lawrence was because of its location and security it offered. When under attack, often by superior forces, Lawrence could retreat to this fort. There the resources of the fortress became his. The food and water stored there supported him and his troops and saved their lives. Sir Lawrence felt confident and secure within its walls. He learned to trust it, and his experience proved its value and trustworthiness.

King David writes about God using words that describe Himself as a "refuge, fort." Like Lawrence's fort, "The Lord is good, a stronghold in the day of trouble; and He knows the ones that trust in Him." Psalm 46:1 shares this, "God is our refuge and strength, an ever-present help in trouble." What an amazing promise to hold on to when life is uncertain and we are looking for help, safety, a place of refuge. Safety is not necessarily found in a place, but a person, the Lord Jesus. "I will never leave you or forsake you" is an amazing guarantee that comes from God Himself.

Maybe you need to be reminded of that today. I know that I need that reminder myself often. "I will never leave or forsake you," and "Come to me, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you and learn from me, for I am gentle and humble in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. For my yoke is easy and my burden is light." Matthew 11:28-30. How blessed we are to belong to Jesus Christ by faith in Him! He will provide, He will keep us safe!
